

RECOMMENDATION FOR THE PREVIOUSLY PUBLISHED, REQUESTED/PROVIDED PUBLIC INFORMATION ON THE WEBSITES OF THE INFORMATION HOLDERS

It is considered a good practice when information holders, through the publication of their websites, make the information requested from them available to all citizens in accordance with the Law on Free Access to Public Information.

Citizens' access to public information is facilitated in this manner because they can obtain the requested information in a faster and more cost-effective manner, with less time wasted and less financial resources.

Furthermore, using previously published, requested/given information is expected to reduce the number of requests for free access and, thus, the obligation of information holders to act on the same.
